Dancers are not required to wear masks on stage.




# Venue Diagram

**Parking:** Please park in the front parking lot (circled in yellow)

**Dancer Drop-Off/Pick-up:** Please enter through the backstage door. There will be signs posted to help you find your dancers dressing room. All dancers are to be dropped off/picked up at the door of their assigned dressing room.

**Front Entrance:** Follow the covered walkway through the gates into the school and make a left to the auditorium lobby



# Winter Show Tickets

## **When will Winter Show tickets go on sale?**

Tickets to Energize Dance Studio's Annual Winter Show will go on sale December 4th at 10:00AM online [HERE >>> https://28926.recitalticketing.com/](https://28926.recitalticketing.com/)

## **Can I purchase tickets at Energize Dance Studio?**

No. Tickets are sold online only, not at the studio.

## **Can I purchase tickets at the time of the show?**

Yes. Tickets can be purchased online only. No tickets will be sold in person at the show. All tickets must be purchased online.

## **How much do tickets cost?**

Tickets are \$16 each plus service fees. Children under 2 years old do not need a ticket if they will be sitting on a lap.

## **Will the seats be socially distanced?**

No. Our venue is at full capacity. We encourage all audience members to wear a mask.

## **Is there a limit on the number of tickets I can purchase?**

All families will be provided with a priority code where they can purchase up to 5 tickets during priority sales. After priority sales end, all remaining tickets will be open to the public during general sales. If you need to purchase more than 5 tickets, any additional tickets can be purchased during general ticket sales. Tickets are sold on a first come first serve basis.

## **Can my dancer watch the show in the audience with me?**

No. Dancers must remain backstage in their assigned dressing room during the duration of the show. All dancers will come back onstage for bows following the final number of the show.

## **Is there a chance that the show my dancer is in will sell out?**

The venue holds 1000 people. All families are allowed up to 5 tickets during priority sales. After priority sales end, all remaining tickets will be open to the general public and are sold on a first come first serve basis.

## **If I have issues with the ticket buying process, who do I contact?**

## **Will my seats be reserved or general admission?**

Seats are assigned based on the best available at the time of purchase. Ticket seating assignments will be sent out with tickets via email approximately 24 hours prior to the start of the show.

## **When can I enter the Venue & Ballroom on the day of the show?**

Dancers may be dropped off backstage at their assigned dressing room beginning at 1:00PM. Doors will open to the lobby at 1:00PM and to the audience at 1:30PM.

# The Big Day!

This is the big day your dancer has worked for all year! Your dancer will be very excited and it's going to be so much fun to take the stage and perform! We want to make this experience the best it can be for you and your dancer, so please continue to read all the details below carefully.

## **When do I need to arrive at the theater?**

Dancers are to arrive at 1:00PM and enter through the backstage door. From there they will be directed to their assigned dressing room where they will check in with the dressing room volunteer.

## **Where do I drop off my dancer?**

Dancers are to be dropped off at their assigned dressing room.

## **Who can drop off my dancer?**

A parent or guardian must drop off the dancer.

## **Check-In Policy & Procedures:**

When checking dancers in, the parent/guardian will receive a ticket. This ticket will need to be provided to pick up your dancer. If this ticket is lost, ID will be required to pick up the dancer.

## **Should my dancer arrive at the venue in costume?**

Yes! Dancers should arrive at the venue in costume, hair, and makeup. We will not be available to help dancers with their hair or makeup before the show. If a dancer is in multiple numbers, they should wear their costume for their first dance in the show.

## **Will my dancer be able to watch the show?**

Dancers will not be able to watch the show. Dancers must stay in their assigned dressing rooms for the duration of the show.

## **Can I Take pictures and Video during the show?**

No. Flash photography and videography is not permitted. It is distracting to dancers on stage. We want our dancers to perform their best so we ask that you please refrain from taking photos and videos during the performance. Video of the show will be available for pre-purchase out in the lobby and after the show.

## **Dismissal Policy & Procedures:**

Following final bows, all dancers will return to their dressing rooms. At this time ONE parent or guardian may come to their dancers assigned dressing room door to pick up their dancer. The parent/guardian picking the dancer up must be the same one that dropped off the dancer. Either their ticket or a valid ID is required to pick up a dancer.

## **Can I go backstage or to the dressing room to assist my dancer in between routines?**

No. Parents/Guardians are not allowed backstage during the show. We will have multiple volunteers and staff members backstage to assist dancers with costume changes. Please make sure your dancer has ALL of their belongings (shoes, costumes, etc.) are labeled with their FULL FIRST and LAST name before the show so we know which costume belongs to which dancer.

# Stage Makeup and Hair

## Does my dancer need to wear makeup for the Winter Show?

Yes! The lights on the stage are very bright, and the auditorium is large! All dancers will need to wear makeup for the show. This will make their beautiful faces stand out on stage and not be washed out by the lights.

For the younger dancers, we suggest blush, glitter and a lip stain, not lipstick. The older dancers should wear blush, lip stain, eye makeup and glitter (optional). All dancers should look their best for the big day! Body glitter is great, too, and adds an extra touch!

## How do I style my dancer's hair for the Winter Show?

For uniformity, we assign each class a specific hairstyle for the performance. This hairstyle is listed in the Show Chart in this packet! Please make sure you are aware of this hairstyle! Hair should be as neat and clean as possible. This is a special day, so you should make a special effort to help your dancer look their best! Use gel/ clips/hairspray to smooth fly-aways so that all dancers have a classy and uniform look on stage! If you have a hairpiece, please also make sure it is very secure so that it does not fall off during the performance!

# Winter Show Costumes & General Information

The following pages contain the list of costume pieces and accessories for each class. Please make sure to double check the class day and time. We have multiple of the same classes with different costumes so make sure you are looking at the correct class. This chart includes details about attire, tights, shoes, accessories and hairstyles. Please reference this chart if you have any questions about your dancers costume or hairstyle for the show.

If you need to purchase a dance dress or tights, please let us know. We have a limited stock available for purchase at the studio.

Please make sure your dancer has all of their belongings clearly labeled with their **FULL NAME**. This includes all dance dresses, shoes, water bottles, shirts, etc.

Any dancers with **more than one dance** in the show should arrive wearing their costume and accessories for their **FIRST** dance. All other Costumes+Accessories should be placed in a zip lock bag **CLEARLY** labeled with the dancers name and class. There will be volunteers backstage to assist with costume changes. Parents are **NOT** permitted backstage during the show.
