#### Will there be a Recital Volunteer Meeting?

Seats are not socially distanced.





# Venue Diagram

Parking: Please park in the front parking lot (circled in yellow)

Dancer Drop-Off/Pick-up: Please enter through the backstage door. There will be signs posted to help you find your dancers dressing room. All dancers are to be dropped off/picked up at the door of their assigned dressing room.

Front Entrance: Follow the covered walkway through the gates into the school and make a left to the auditorium lobby

# Recital Tickets

## **When will Candyland Show tickets go on sale?**

Tickets to Energize Dance Studio's Year-End Show, Candyland, will go on sale May 28th at 10:00AM online [HERE >> https://28926.recalticketing.com/](https://28926.recalticketing.com/)

## **Can I purchase tickets at Energize Dance Studio?**

No. Tickets are sold online only, not at the studio.

## **Can I purchase tickets at the time of the show?**

Yes. Tickets can be purchased online only. No tickets will be sold in person at the show. All tickets must be purchased online. Tickets will be available for purchase until the start of the show at 3pm on June 12th.

## **How much do tickets cost?**

Tickets are \$20 each plus service fees. Children under 1 years old do not need a ticket if they will be sitting on a lap.

## **Will the seats be socially distanced?**

No. Our venue is at full capacity. We encourage all audience members to wear a mask.

## **Is there a limit on the number of tickets I can purchase?**

No. All families may purchase an unlimited number of tickets. Tickets are sold on a first come first serve basis. Make sure to purchase your tickets early to get the seats you want!

## **Can my dancer watch the show in the audience with me?**

No. Dancers must remain backstage in their assigned dressing room during the duration of the show. All dancers will come back on stage for bows following the final number of the show.

## **Is there a chance that the show my dancer is in will sell out?**

The venue holds 1000 people. All families are allowed an unlimited number of tickets. We do not expect to sell out, however we do recommend getting your tickets early to get the seats you want. Seats are chosen on a first come first serve basis.

## **If I have issues with the ticket buying process, who do I contact?**

## **Will my seats be reserved or general admission?**

Seats are chosen at the time of purchase. Seat Numbers will appear on your ticket.

## **When can I enter the Venue & Ballroom on the day of the show?**

Dancers may be dropped off backstage at their assigned dressing room beginning at 2:00PM. Doors will open to the lobby at 2:00PM and to the audience at 2:30PM.

## **Do I need to show my ticket when I arrive?**

Yes. Tickets will be scanned at the door when you arrive. Please have your ticket either pulled up on your phone or printed to be scanned upon entry.

# Dress Rehearsal

Dress Rehearsal is a very important part of the Recital experience. Dress Rehearsal is the first time the dancers will perform full-out in their costume with their hair and makeup complete. Dress Rehearsal will take place at ENERGIZE DANCE STUDIO on Saturday June 4, 2022.

## **When is Dress Rehearsal?**

Saturday June 4, 2022. All classes will have a 20 min time slot to practice their dance during. Please refer to the next page for your dancers time block.

## **Where is Dress Rehearsal?**

## **What time do I arrive at Dress Rehearsal?**

Please refer to the chart on the next page for your dancers dress rehearsal time. Please arrive 10 minutes prior to their rehearsal time.

## **Can I expect the Dress Rehearsal schedule to run on time?**

Yes. Each class has 20 minutes to run their dance and take a group photo. There are 10 minutes in between each class for dancers to leave, enter, or change.

## **When I arrive for Dress Rehearsal, where do I go?**

When you arrive for dress rehearsal please wait outside and line up at the front door to drop your dancer off. One of our faculty members will come and get the dancers for their rehearsal. The lobby will be CLOSED to parents to allow all our dancers space to change.

## **Should my dancer arrive to Dress Rehearsal in costume?**

Yes. Dancers should arrive to dress rehearsal in their costume with their hair and makeup done. If they are in multiple routines they should be dressed for their first routine and bring their other costumes with them.

## **Will there be a changing area for my dancer who has multiple routines/costumes for Dress Rehearsal?**

Yes! Our lobby will be blocked off and converted into a dressing room for dancers. If your dancer is in multiple routines please have them bring all of their coostumes when they arrive for their first dance.

## **Can I video my dancer at Dress Rehearsal?**

No. Parents are not allowed in the studio during dress rehearsal.

## **How long should I plan on being at Dress Rehearsal?**

You should plan on being at dress rehearsal for the duration of your child's class(es). Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the start of their class' rehearsal. We will be sticking to a strict time schedule to make sure everyone has time to practice so please arrive on time. We will not take extra rehearsal time for daners who arrive late.

## **Where do I pick up my dancer?**

Dancers will be dismissed out the BACK door of the studio. Please drive around to the back of the building at the end of their rehersal where we will have a staff member dismissing dancers.

# The Big Day!

This is the big day your dancer has worked for all year! Your dancer will be very excited and it's going to be so much fun to take the stage and perform! We want to make this experience the best it can be for you and your dancer, so please continue to read all the details below carefully.

## **When do I need to arrive at the theater?**

Dancers are to arrive at 2:00PM and enter through the backstage door. From there they will be directed to their assigned dressing room where they will check in with the dressing room volunteer.

## **Where do I drop off my dancer?**

Dancers are to be dropped off at their assigned dressing room. Dressing room assignments will be posted on the wall when you first enter.

## **Who can drop off my dancer?**

A parent or guardian must drop off the dancer.

## **Check-In Policy & Procedures:**

When checking dancers in, the dancer and parent/guardian will receive matching wristbands. This wristband will need to be provided to pick up your dancer. The names on the wristbands must match. If this wristband is lost, ID will be required to pick up the dancer.

## **Should my dancer arrive at the venue in costume?**

Yes! Dancers should arrive at the venue in costume, hair, and makeup. We will not be available to help dancers with their hair or makeup before the show. If a dancer is in multiple numbers, they should wear their costume for their first dance in the show.

## **Will my dancer be able to watch the show?**

Dancers will not be able to watch the show. Dancers must stay in their assigned dressing rooms for the duration of the show.

## **Can I Take pictures and Video during the show?**

No. Flash photography and videography is not permitted. It is distracting to dancers on stage. We want our dancers to perform their best so we ask that you please refrain from taking photos and videos during the performance. All families will receive a video download of the show after the performance.

## **Dismissal Policy & Procedures:**

Following final bows:

All dancers will return to their dressing rooms. At this time ONE parent or guardian may come to their dancer's assigned dressing room door to pick up their dancer. The parent/guardian picking the dancer up must be the same one that dropped off the dancer. Either their wristband or a valid ID is required to pick up a dancer.

## **Can I go backstage or to the dressing room to assist my dancer in between routines?**

No. Parents/Guardians are not allowed backstage during the show. We will have multiple volunteers and staff members backstage to assist dancers with costume changes. Please make sure your dancer has ALL of their belongings (shoes, costumes, etc.) are labeled with their FULL FIRST and LAST name before the show so we know which costume belongs to which dancer.

# Stage Makeup and Hair

## Does my dancer need to wear makeup for the Year-End Show?

Yes! The lights on the stage are very bright, and the auditorium is large! All dancers will need to wear makeup for the show. This will make their beautiful faces stand out on stage and not be washed out by the lights.

For the younger dancers, we suggest blush, glitter and a lip stain, not lipstick. The older dancers should wear blush, lip stain, eye makeup and glitter (optional). All dancers should look their best for the big day! Body glitter is great, too, and adds an extra touch!

## How do I style my dancer's hair for the Year-End Show?

For uniformity, we assign each class a specific hairstyle for the performance. This hairstyle is listed in the Recital Costume Chart in this packet! Please make sure you are aware of the hairstyle! Hair should be as neat and clean as possible. This is a special day, so you should make a special effort to help your dancer look their best! Use gel/bobby pins/hairspray to smooth fly-aways so that all dancers have a classy and uniform look on stage! If you have a hairpiece, please also make sure it is very secure with clips and bobby pins so that it does not fall off during the performance!

# Recital Costumes

The following pages contain the list of costume pieces and accessories for each class. Please make sure to double check the class day and time. We have multiple of the same classes with different costumes so make sure you are looking at the correct class. This chart includes details about tights, shoes, accessories and hairstyles. Please reference this chart if you have any questions about your dancers costume or hairstyle for the show.

Please make sure your dancer has all of their belongings clearly labeled with their **FULL NAME**. This includes all garment bags, dance bags, shoes, water bottles, shirts, etc.

Any dancers with **more than one dance** in the show should arrive wearing their costume and accessories for their **FIRST** dance. All other Costumes+Accessories should be placed in either a zip lock bag or garment bag **CLEARLY** labeled with the dancers name and class.

There will be volunteers backstage to assist with costume changes. Parents are **NOT** permitted backstage during the show.
